- C.7.54 (2i-vii)**      ***Letters to Ernest Broxap concerning his book *The Great Civil War in Lancashire, its publication and sales****      **[?1650s] & 1909-1915**
- There is also 1 miscellaneous, undated letter which appears to date from 1650s (2vii).
- The Great Civil War in Lancashire* was first published in 1910 by Manchester University Press.
- C.7.54 (2i)      Letter from T. F. Tout, Manchester University, to Ernest Broxap enclosing 2 copies of the agreement re the publication of Broxap's book *The Great Civil War in Lancashire*.      25 Jan 1909
- With copy of the agreement with Manchester University Press signed by Tout and Broxap, and a statement of sales and expenses on the book for 1921-1923.
- C.7.54 (2ii)      Letter from James Tait, Manchester University, to Ernest Broxap, Higher Broughton co Lancs, concerning indentures exacted from members of the first Protectorate Parliament.      13 May 1909
- With a copy of the indenture of a Burgess of Parliament, 1654, in Broxap's hand.
- C.7.54 (2iii)      Letter from T. F. Tout, Manchester University, to Ernest Broxap, and a letter from Mr Sherratt to Professor Tout, in envelope addressed to Broxap.      28 Jan 1909 & 27 Jan 1910
- Letter from Tout to Broxap: "We have accepted Sherratt's estimate for printing your book, and I have told him to start as soon as possible". Letter from Sherratt to Tout compliments Broxap's book and notes that the maps need re-drawing for publication.
- C.7.54 (2iv)      Letter from H. M. McKechnie, secretary of the University of Manchester Publications Committee to Ernest Broxap, Kersal.      18 Jul 1912
- Enclosing a statement of the sales and expenses of Broxap's book *The Great Civil War in Lancashire* for 1910-1912.
